



Join Cub Scout Pack 815!

What is Cub Scouting? Imagine a program that can help your son learn, grow, and mature while he is having fun. There are activities in which you and he can participate together with the rest of the family and get to know each other even better. This is exactly what Scouting is. Every activity gives you and your son the chance to discover and share together.

Pack 815 runs a complete Cub Scouting program for first through fifth grade boys. Our program involves outings, hiking, and other outdoor activities.

Bobcat/Tiger Cubs is an exciting program for first grade boys and adult family members. Each Tiger and parent meets as a Den once or twice per month to work on activities from the Tiger handbook. A Den consists of 5 to 8 cubs and their parents with one or two adults serving as Den Coach. It's a great way for your son to make friends.

Wolf Cub Scouts is a program for second grade boys and **Bear Cub Scouts** is a program for third grade boys. These scouts usually meet twice per month as a Den, typically at the leader's home or at school. At Den meetings, scouts work on achievements from their handbooks which involve skill development, physical activity, skits, and helping in our community. They also go on several outings each year.

Webelos is a two year transition program between Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts for fourth and fifth grade boys. The boys use their handbooks and have planned activities to explore their community, people, hobbies, and scout skills. Some of their activities are done with area Boy Scout Troops.

The Pack consists of all the dens. A Pack Meeting is held once a month for all dens and their families, including siblings, to come together and participate in a special activity, ceremony of advancement or to watch the boys play games and perform skits.

The Pack offers families regularly planned outings, hikes, service projects, and special events. Some of our activities and outings in the past have included:
